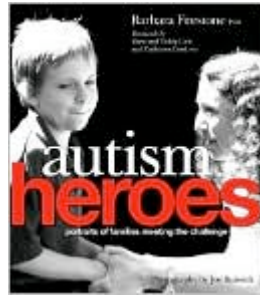

### **Autism Heroes. Portraits of Families Meeting the Challenge**

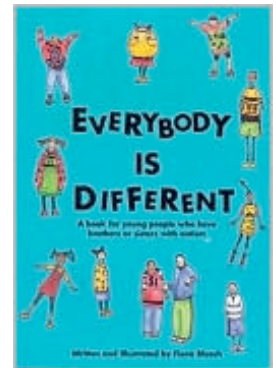
